



CREATE A PIECE OF ARTWORK TO BE EXHIBITED PUBLICLY AT SAWTOOTH GALLERY, LAUNCESTON.

The work can be in any medium (drawing, painting, photography, sculpture, mixed media, digital art, animation etc.) but must address the theme of Head, Heart Hand. In Big Picture terms this means;

Head (for thinking and talking)

Heart (for emotions and relationships)

Hand (for making and creating)

Your artwork can relate to any or all of these, but think broadly.....

Head might relate to a portrait. Who could you photograph, draw or paint that would be a worthy subject? A world famous humanitarian like Nelson Mandela or a brother or sister? Head might also be about what you are thinking? What consumes your mind? What gets you pumped?

Heart could be reflected by an image of what or who you love. What are you passionate about? How could you represent different feelings? How do different colours make you feel? Your artwork does not have to be representational- it could be an abstract painting of how or what you feel.

Hand could be represented in many different ways - producing anything with your hands reflects making and creating. A clay or wire sculpture or perhaps some found objects could be fun to experiment with.

Brainstorm. Create a mind-map of potential ideas and select a few to tease out and experiment with.

Design. Sketch. Snap. Use a pen, brush, computer or the camera on your phone.

Over the next weeks we will be conducting masterclasses in various mediums for you to experiment and explore.

You don't have to create a masterpiece to begin with.

Most of all, you should have fun. Use this opportunity to showcase what you love to do and also your skills.
